From the AAUW Board:

The board has given a lot of thought recently to our presence in the community and to getting our name and mission into the public view. We can no longer count on publicity from the RRS but have to find other ways to reach new members.

To do this, members have signed up for space at City Market and at the "Womanfest" breakfast. Many of our members also participate in LWV and YWCA events and our publicity chair has sent our event postings to the smaller papers.

We feel that we need materials ready to go to hand out in such situations or anytime we meet a potential new member. We have had Rockford Area branch brochures the past two years and also have recently purchased business-type AAUW cards from national which we can print with board member names.

Our budget is very lean; we use almost all of our \$14.00 per member local dues for programs and communications with smaller amounts for insurance and other expenses. (You will be able to see the details in the budget in the annual meeting packet).

Our dues have not increased locally for a number of years. We have absorbed all the increases in postage, printing and insurance and have saved a lot because most people receive email. Our Schnucks income has helped with branch expenses, too.

Printing branch brochures costs about \$180.00. Card stock costs \$10.00 per 100. We feel that they are a necessity to present our branch and mission to potential members.

To balance our budget with this extra expense, we are recommending a dues increase of \$3.00 for the 2014-2015 year. Dues would be \$76.00 (that amount includes \$49.00 Association, \$10.00 IL and \$17.00 local).

We hope that you will support our rationale and will approve this request at the annual meeting. You may call any board member with questions before or ask them at the meeting.
